### Highlights from the last meeting

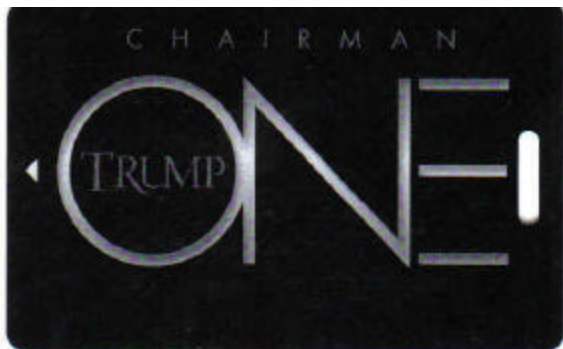
- Trump Marina's \$10 "Atlantic City Air Show" won 2006 Chip of the Year
