<p>California – Viejas Casino.</p> <p>Front side is identical to previous issue; the backside is the same except for a small “TM adjacent to the top right side of “S” in Viejas. 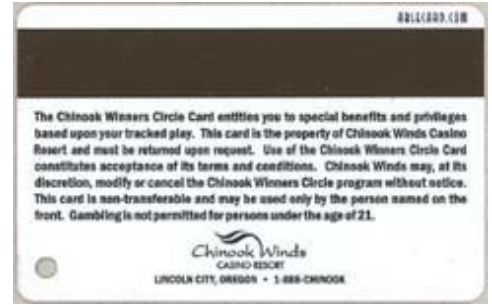
