News & Notes: Things that could bring new or changed TITO's, & TITO News.

1. Hooters Casino in LV, NV is being sold and most likely will be re-branded as an upscale property, the same investor group is also planning a Hooters Casino in West Wendover, NV The money for LV deal may be somewhat in question which may delay the deal.
2. Fort Cheyenne Casino in North Las Vegas will be renamed The Mystic and expanded and refurbished. TITO's?
3. In the FL Miami-Dade area slots are expected after voter approval in Jan 08 elections at Flagler Dog Track, Miami Jai-Alai and Calder Race Course. Construction is expected to take 18 mo. to 2 years with 1500-2000 slots per location.
4. A new casino is under construction in Natchez, MS, no name yet, expect a 2009 opening.
5. The Nevada Palace Casino in LV, NV closed 2/29/08 to make room for the future under construction Eastside Cannery Casino & Hotel which should open later this year, expect TITO's. The Nevada Palace TITO's are now OBS.
6. Twin Pines Casino in CA is reported to now have TITO's.
7. The HoChunk Tribe is developing a small 600 slot casino north of Whittenberg, WI, slots only, it should have TITO's when it opens in the fall of 2008.
8. Harrah's Entertainment is changing its name to Caesars Entertainment Corp. Expect to see revised TITO's with the new Corp. name. they will still use the Harrah's name on casinos.
9. Casino Windsor Canada becomes Caesars Windsor June 19, 2008, expect new TITO's.
10. "Guaranteed Play" a patented table game and slot play system now has its own form of TITO's. You buy a TITO that gives you a fixed number of slot plays for a fixed price win or lose. It is unlikely we will see many of these Guaranteed Play TITO's as they are taken in by the slot machine. I expect the only ones collectors might see are any sent out as promos and then do not get used when the patron does not visit the casino.
11. A press report indicated that some Class II slots are installed in Alaska, at present no Alaska TITO's are cataloged, who will find the first ?
12. Trump Marina Casino, AC, NJ will be sold and become a Margaritaville casino.

13. A casino is being proposed for the far NW corner of IA near Sioux Falls, SD by the operators of the Riverside Casino in IA.
14. Downstream Casino operated by the Quapaw tribe in NE OK near Joplin, MO opened July 5, 2008, expect TITO's.
15. Stoney Nakoda Casino opened with 300 slots west of Calgary in Canada, June 2008, expect TITO's.
16. Aliante Station Casino in N. LV. Will open Nov. 11, 2008.
17. Wild Rose Casino, Clinton, IA opened. Expect TITO's.
18. Hollywood Slots in Bangor, ME moved into expanded facilities in June, we still are waiting to see TITO's from ME.
19. Kewadin Casinos are re-branding with a new logo, expect new TITO's.
20. With the parent company of Tropicana in bankruptcy expect some of their 13 casinos to be sold, have name changes, and have new TITO's.
21. The small temp. Seneca Buffalo Creek Casino in Buffalo, NY has been ruled illegal as a Class III casino, it may be required to close or reconfigure as a Class II operation. It remains open for now. Get TITO's for your collection if you do not have them.
22. Eagle River Casino in Alberta, Canada has been reported to have 250 slots with TITO's.
23. Two additional Wild Fire locals' casinos have been opened in Henderson, NV by Stations Casinos. Expect new TITOs. One is the renamed Magic Star Casino.
24. Riverwalk Casino in Vicksburg, MS is scheduled to open in Nov. 2008.
25. The Buffalo Thunder Casino opens 08/12 in the Santa Fe area in NM, expect TITO's

Special Note: In Jan. 2008 I started on Ver. 2 of the TITO catalog, most likely it will come out on CDROM, I hope to publish it later in 2008. I expect it will cover about 2000 different TITO's.

Most likely Newsletter #18 will be the last of these TITO Newsletters.
